Student Uniform Dress Code

A uniform dress code reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instills recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school. Issues of equality, health and safety, and expense are also factors that contribute to the establishment of the Dress Code. Student uniforms are available for purchase at the school office. Please ensure all garments have your child's name marked clearly on them.

GIRLS: Summer and Winter Uniform

- Blue checkered uniform dress OR School shirt, navy shorts or skorts cut just above the knee
- Visible white socks
- School tracksuit or a plain navy tracksuit
- Blue school hat with full brim and badge
- Sports uniform Monday and Friday

School shirt, navy shorts or sports skort, joggers and visible white socks

BOYS: Summer & Winter Uniform

- School shirt and navy shorts
- Visible grey socks
- School tracksuit or plain navy tracksuit
- Blue school hat with full brim and badge
- Sports uniform Monday and Friday

School shirt, navy shorts, joggers and visible white socks

Condition of Uniform	Students' uniform must be clean, neat and in good order.
	Damaged uniform items must be replaced.
	The Dress Code applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions.
	If for any reason children are not in correct school uniform the class teacher should be informed.
Jewellery	Only the following jewellery may be worn:
	Wrist watch
	Small gold or silver cross / religious medallion on a chain
	Plain small sleepers or studs (one earring permitted per ear)
	MJR wristband, medical alert and mosquito band or similar are the only items allowed on students arms other than a watch
	The following items should not be worn at school:
	Bracelets or jewelry are not to be worn on any part of the leg.
	Visible body piercing other than the ear is not allowed.
Hair	Unkempt hairstyles are not permitted
	Hair, when shoulder length or longer, or covering the ears is to be tied back completely.
	Hair is to be neat and tidy
	Fringes are not to hang over the face.
	Coloured hair (fully or partially dyed) is not allowed at all. Hair is to be student's own natural colour.
	All ribbons, headbands etc worn by children must be blue, white, black or brown, red or yellow in colour.
	 Extreme haircuts (e.g. tracks, spikes, Mohawks, rats tails, undercuts) are not permitted.
	If doubt exists with a style of hair, a student or parent should check with

	the Principal before having a style change.
	The Principal may make allowances for special days.
'Free Dress' Days	On 'free dress' days, students must wear appropriate clothing which is not revealing and doesn't carry inappropriate images or messages.
	Sun safe practices must be followed.
	Thongs and scuffs are not permitted.
Make-Up	Make-up is not permitted to be worn
Under garments & clothing in cold weather	Underwear should not be visible
clothing in cold weather	Short sleeved t-shirts under students' school uniform should not be visible.
	Swimwear is not to be worn under the school uniform unless required
	 Children are permitted to wear a navy/white skivvy or a long sleeved t- shirt under the school uniform. Navy tights/stockings can be worn under the school uniform
Fingernails	Fingernails should be trimmed to fingertip length.
	Coloured fingernail polish is not permitted
Security	All clothing should be clearly marked with student's name.
Acceptable	The Principal retains the right to decide what is acceptable.
